I have been traveling to Nicaragua since 2014 and I have never felt unsafe. Although I am not an international travel safety expert, I have been leading teams for 25 years and I can tell you that Nicaragua is peaceful and the rough roads and mosquitoes are the biggest inconvenience. It is one man's opinion and travel/construction/activities carry inherent risk, but we do our best to keep people safe. Reach out to me personally with your concerns - I'll chat with you.

Nicaragua has been generally peaceful for some time, despite protests at times. We have plans in place in the event of a natural disaster or other event. Tourism is the #1 industry in Nicaragua due to the low cost of travel and beautiful beaches and general safe environment.

All participants should check with their doctor for recommended medications before traveling to Nicaragua.

All participants are required to have medical and evacuation insurance (provided by uReach at a low daily cost) even though it has never been needed in 25 years of leading teams. That's how seriously we take your safety.
